11601 – FIRST YEAR FEEDER CLASS

This is open to all First Year Feeders who have never exhibited a market steer or market heifer at a county fair. Any breed of market steer or market heifer is eligible. Market steers or market heifers will compete in their respective classes. This class may be a Livestock Sale position at the discretion of the superintendent; however, it must factor into the Livestock Sale percentage as per Junior Livestock Sale Rules.

11602 – ROOSEVELT COUNTY BRED BEEF CLASS

1. All market steers and market heifers will be shown in one class.
2. There shall be no weight limit on market steers or market heifers.
3. Market steers and market heifers will be bedded on cedar fiber only.
4. **Neck ropes:** For the safety of the animal, exhibitor and general public, neck ropes for steers are recommended while in stalls.
5. **There will be one (1) Livestock Sale position for this class.**
6. All market steers and market heifers must meet State TB requirements.
7. Each exhibitor can show only one county bred market steer or market heifer.

1. See Junior Livestock Special Rules.
2. The division is open to all market steers and market heifers under two years of age.
3. Weigh in will be Wednesday morning, August 21, 2024 at 10:00 am.
4. Market steers and market heifers will be divided by weight into classes by the Superintendent.
5. There shall be no weight limit on market steers or market heifers.
6. Number of classes will depend on number of market steers and market heifers with a maximum of four (4) market steer classes.
7. The next class will be called immediately after the current class.
8. Market steers and market heifers will be bedded on cedar fiber only.
9. **Neck ropes:** For the safety of the animal, exhibitor and general public, neck ropes for market steers and market heifers are recommended while in stalls.
10. All classes must factor into a Livestock Sale position to form a separate class.
11. All market steers and market heifers must meet State TB requirements.
12. Market Heifer class will be available with a separate sale hole if there are enough entries to justify a class, and it will factor into the Livestock Sale percentage as per Junior Livestock Sale Rules at the Superintendents discretion.
13. Market Heifers are not eligible to be shown in the Breeding Beef Show.

2. Open to any youth in Roosevelt County who has not reached their 20th birthday by January 1st of current year
3. All Breeding Beef must meet State TB requirements
4. Breeding Beef will be bedded on cedar fiber only
5. **Neck ropes:** For the safety of the animal, exhibitor, and general public, neck ropes for animals are mandatory while in stalls
6. All breeds of cattle will be shown in the same age class

Rules and Regulations:

Age Requirement: Minimum age is 5 years old on show day
Maximum age is if the exhibitor is not eligible for the market show at the Roosevelt County Fair.

Predominate Dairy Calves will show in the Replacement Dairy Heifer Show and **MUST** be on the fairgrounds Monday, August 19, 2024.

Predominant Beef Calves will show in the Beef Show and WILL NOT need to be on the fairgrounds until Wednesday, August 21, 2024.

VALIDATION IS NOT REQUIRED

NO SALE SLOT FOR BUCKET CALF SHOWS

Exhibitors in bucket calf show are not eligible for the Showmanship, Herdsmanship or 1st year feeder awards.

No later than July 26, 2024 at 5:00 pm.

For other rules and regulation:

1. See the Junior Livestock Rules
2. See the Market Beef Rules
3. See the Replacement Dairy Replacement Dairy Heifer
4. Beef bucket calf can be a steer or heifer.
5. Dairy bucket calf must be a heifer
6. Bucket Calf must be weaned and the maximum weight will be 400 pounds
7. If the exhibitor has more than one (1) bucket calf, must have another booster (see age requirements) to show for them.
8. Predominate beef bucket calves will show during the Market Beef Show
9. Predominate dairy bucket calves will show during the Replacement Dairy Heifer Show.
