Show will be in the Special Events Arena beginning at 8:00 AM with the Kid Pony class and will run in the same order as the classes listed in the fair book

General Information:

- Entry is \$6 per class/per horse and will be made at the extension office by the deadline.
- Horses are not required to be registered. Exhibitor must have access to or own horse 90 days prior to the show and be able to prove ownership.
- Only horses that have been entered for the show are allowed on the grounds on show day and no horses will be stalled at the fair.
- All junior livestock rules applying to health are to be followed as pertains to horses (see rule 13 and 14) in junior livestock special rules. **Superintendent and/or the judge reserves the right to dismiss any exhibitor with a lame or sick horse from the show and the fairgrounds.**
- All dogs are to be kept on a lease during the show.
- A clinic will be held prior to the show to help anyone interested in showing to understand all classes and procedures. Clinic date, time, and location to be announced later. Watch for Facebook notifications or contact the superintendent.
- Exhibitors must be unmarried, regularly enrolled student of Roosevelt County, or a 4-H or FFA member in good standing and not passed their 20th birthday by January 1 of the current year. If younger than school age, must be a Roosevelt County resident.
- Judged by AQHA rules. For example, long sleeved shirts, boots, hats, and belt are required dress (AQHA rule book www.aqha.com). Judge may waive the hat rule if wind requires. Please follow all tack rules also as per AQHA. For example, no hackamores, tie downs, etc. See rule AQHA rule book.
- Senior age group 15 – 19
- Junior age group 10 – 14
- Novice age group 9 and under – these will be Walk/Trot classes only. If you are in this age group and want to lope then you may move up to the 10- 14 age group but you must stay in that age group for all performance classes throughout the show beginning with showmanship.
- Patterns for horsemanship, trail, and ranch riding will be posted a week early in the office and at the arena the day of the show.
- Classes included in high point and reserve high point buckle awards include: showmanship, western pleasure, horsemanship, trail, and ranch riding. Exhibitor with the highest accumulation of points in all classes will be awarded high point and reserve high point in their respective division.

- Ribbons given for placings 1st – 6th and points given as follows:
1st – 6 points, 2nd – 5 points, 3rd – 4 points, 4th – 3 points, 5th – 2 points, 6th – 1 point

HALTER DIVISION – no stallions other than weanlings

- 14001 Kid Pony – Ponies must be 62” and under. Ribbons only. No premiums.
Award will be given for the pony with the best attitude and interactions with the handler in and out of arena.
- 14002 Halter Mares – 5 and under
- 14003 Halter Mares – 6 and older

Grand and Reserve Mare will be chosen from the winners in both classes.

- 14004 Halter Gelding – 5 and under
- 14006 Halter Gelding – 6 and older

Grand and Reserve Gelding will be chosen from the winners in both classes.

First through sixth place ribbons will be given at the show. All buckle awards will be given at the awards presentation on Friday August 23, 2024 at 5:00 in the Events Arena. In case of a tie, the first tie breaker will be the one with the most 1st places. Second tie breaker will be the winner of the horsemanship class if needed.
