## 12001 – FIRST YEAR FEEDER CLASS

Judge: Koby Cone

This is open to all first-year feeders who have never exhibited swine at a county fair. Any breed of swine is eligible. Swine will compete in their respective classes. This class will be strictly judged on the swine. This class is eligible for a Livestock Sale position upon choice of superintendent, however, must factor into a Livestock Sale position percentage as per Junior Livestock Sale Rules.

## 12002 – ROOSEVELT COUNTY BRED SWINE CLASS

3. Any breed or weight of swine is eligible.
4. Each exhibitor can show only one country bred pig.

# MARKET SWINE SHOW

1. See Junior Livestock Special Rules
2. Junior Exhibitors may show either barrows or gilts in market class.
3. **Minimum weight for market swine will be 180 pounds and maximum weight will be 280 pounds.**
4. Swine will be weighed (on official county scale) as they are unloaded from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm and classified at 5:00 pm, Monday, August 19, 2024. Swine under the minimum or over the maximum weight will have a chance to re-weigh after all swine have been weighed in. All swine that do not make the second weigh-in will not be eligible to show.
5. Classes will be set up by the Superintendent as deemed most fair to all.
6. BREED CLASSES will be:
  - 12003 – Black OPB (Spots, Polands, Berks, Pietrain)
  - 12004 – Duroc
  - 12006 – Hampshires
  - 12006 – White OPB (Chester Whites, Landrace)
  - 12007 – Yorkshires
  - 12008 – Crosses
7. All breed classes must factor into a livestock sale position to form a separate class.
